



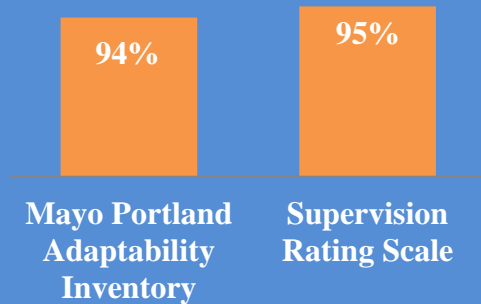
# Supported Living System

ReMed's Supported Living System (SLS) provides long-term rehabilitation and supported living to individuals in community-based apartments. Services are provided seven days a week, 24-hours a day. On average, current individuals in the apartment programs receive .50-1 hours of Psych treatment weekly. All therapies are available for individuals in this program as determined by their treatment plan. These individuals are capable of performing self-care tasks and demonstrate skills sufficient to live in a community setting with structure and support services.

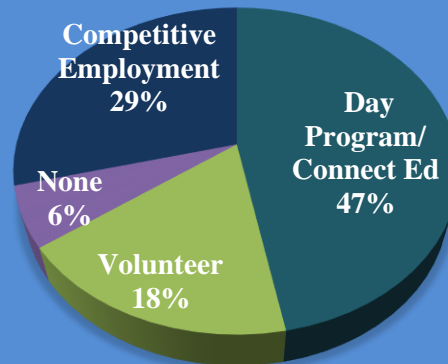

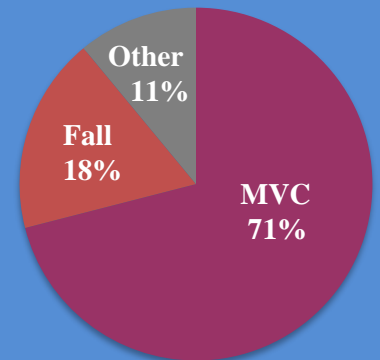
### CRS-Apt. Vocational / Avocational Status



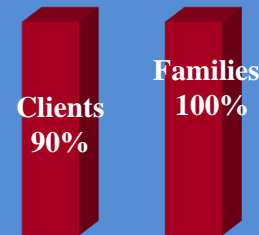

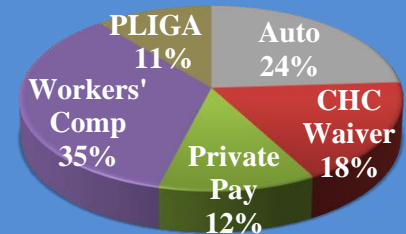
### CRS-Apt. Cause of Injury

## Medical/Rehab Nursing Support and Care Coordination

Physiatry (Paoli & PGH), Neuropsychiatry & Neurology (Paoli only) care provided through regular visits. Medical Director on-call 24 hours/day.  
 NP available for medical issues (Paoli only).  
 Rehabilitation Case Manager Monday through Friday. Physician and Nursing oversight provided.  
 RN and clinical on-call services 24 hours/day.  
 Psychology available 24 hours/day for psychiatric crisis/suicidality.

## Therapy Services

Clinical Specialist skilled in Rehabilitation.  
 Available therapies include: PT, OT, Speech/Language, Psychology, Drug & Alcohol Counseling, Cognitive Rehabilitation and Therapeutic Recreation. On avg. individuals receive 1-2 hours of individual and group therapy services a week. Vocational services available. Music and Art Therapies available in Paoli only.  
 Therapists assist individuals in the development of independent living, positive social skills, and participation in a productive stable activity plan.  
 Therapists available as needed for therapy on site, in the clinic and as a consultant to the team.

## Staffing & Services

### Staffing

Staffing ratios of 1:4.  
 Serves individuals with Low to Moderate Acuity.  
 Staff assistance provided for job support/coaching, leisure activities, residential tasks, and for safety as needed to access and remain in the community.  
 Staff support provided or available daily; including during overnight.  
 Staff skilled in: advanced brain injury rehabilitation, community integration skills.  
 CBIS certified staff.  
 Individuals are assisted with transportation and training is provided for public transportation if appropriate.



# NeuroBehavioral/NeuroRehab System

Long-term supported living settings provide an intensively staffed and structured environment for individuals who demonstrate problematic behaviors of a low frequency and low to moderate intensity. Treatment focuses on the utilization of compensatory strategies to manage behavior, increase the individual's awareness, communication and coping skills, and develop a stable activity plan. On average, current individuals in this setting receive .5 hours of Physical Therapy monthly and .5 hours of Psych treatment weekly.

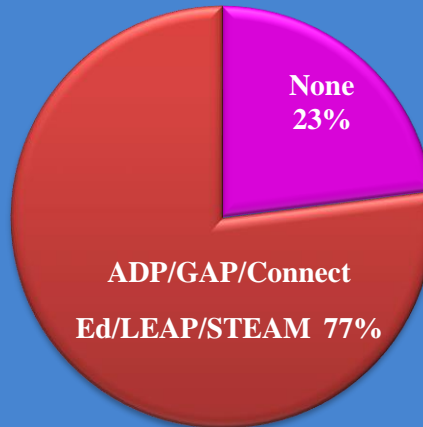

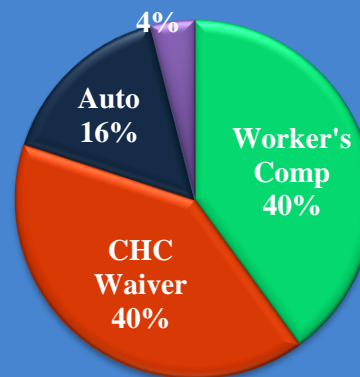
### LT NeuroBehavioral Program's Vocational/Avocational Status



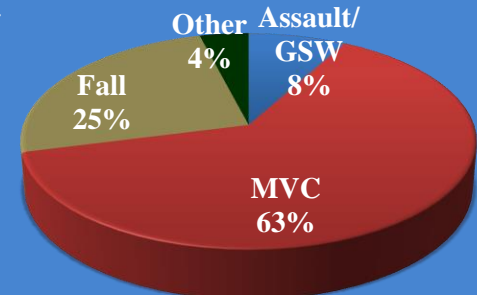

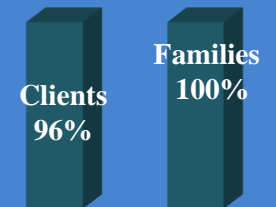

## Medical/Rehab Nursing Support and Care Coordination

Physiatry and Neuropsychiatry provide weekly on-site visits. Medical Director & Neuropsychiatry on-call 24 hours/day.

NP available as needed for medical issues.

Rehabilitation Case Manager full-time; Physician and Nursing oversight provided; RN/clinical on-call services 24 hours/day.

Psychology available for urgent psychiatric crisis/suicidality.

## Therapy Services

Clinical Specialist skilled in brain injury rehabilitation and behavioral programming. Available therapies include PRN: Behavior Analysis, PT, OT, Speech, Psychology, Drug & Alcohol counseling. Therapeutic Recreation, Music & Art Therapies, and Vocational Services.

Therapists assist the individual with behavior management, coping and communication skills. TRs support participation in productive activities and access to the community.

Therapists available on site or as a consultant to the team.

## Staffing & Services

### Staffing

Staffing ratios of 1:3; staffing able to increase quickly in response to behavioral/mood changes. Serves individuals with Moderate to High Acuity.

Staff skilled in: behavioral techniques and data collection, CPI (crisis prevention) certification, advanced brain injury rehabilitation skills. CBIS certified staff.



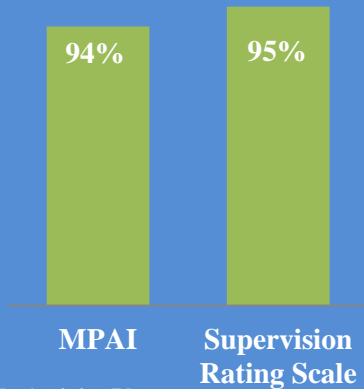
# Supported Living System

ReMed's Supported Living System (SLS) provides long-term rehabilitation to individuals who require varying levels of support on a 24-hour basis. Residential services are provided in small houses with a structured, semi-independent environment. Individuals are capable of performing most self-care tasks and demonstrate skills sufficient to live in a community setting with structure and staff support. Services are provided seven days a week, 24-hours a day. On average, current individuals in SLS receive 1 hour of Physical Therapy, 1 hour of Occupational Therapy, .5 hours of Speech Therapy, and 4 hours of Psych treatment monthly.

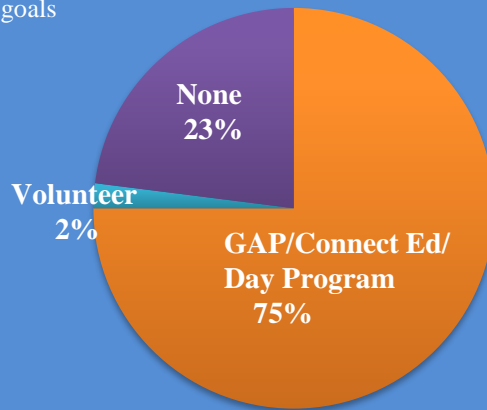

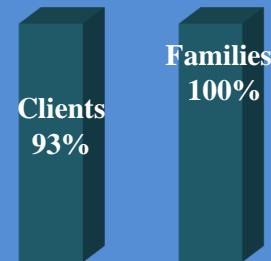
### CRS-Houses Vocational / Avocational Status



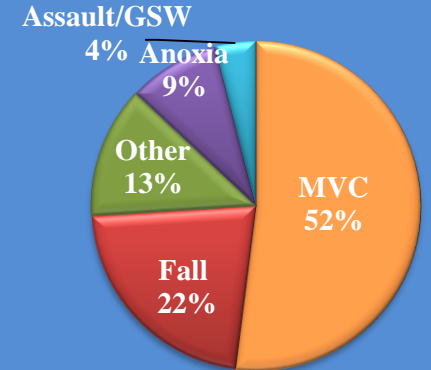

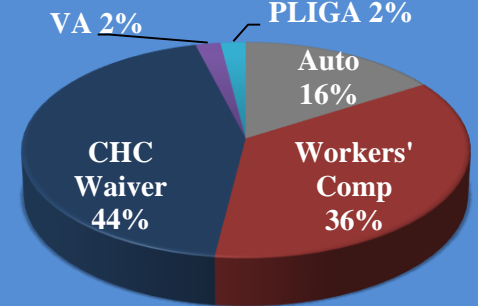
### CRS-Houses Satisfaction with Services

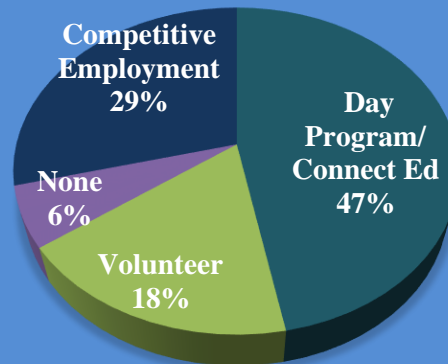

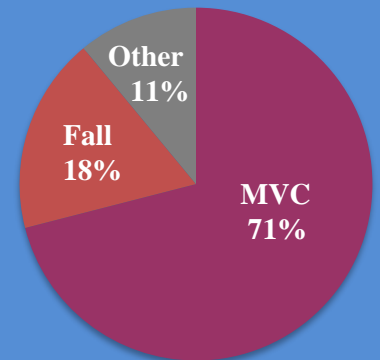
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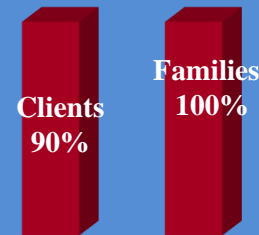
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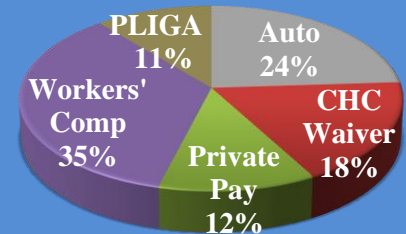
### CRS-Apt. Cause of Injury
